Montreux-Reichersberg = approx. 700 Km, 7 1/2 hours without breaks

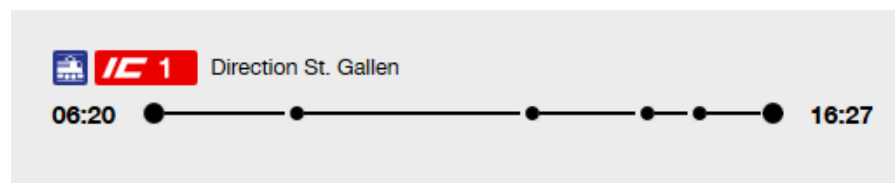


B) *Via Innsbruck*, count another one to two hours

Price : approx. 720.– €, includes teaching and workshops,
10 nights bed and breakfast, to be paid on arrival at the Stift
reception, cash or credit card accepted. Meals are not included
and are paid at the restaurant (no room accounts possible).
